## ***Daustinia*, a replacement name for *Austinia* (Convolvulaceae)**

Buril *et al.* (2013) transferred a Brazilian species of *Jacquemontia* Choisy to the new genus *Austinia* Buril & A.R. Simões, named after Daniel F. Austin (1943–2015). However, the name *Austinia* was already occupied by a genus of a moss family, Fabroniaceae, described in 1875 by Johann Karl August Müller. The later homonym *Austinia* Buril & A.R. Simões is, therefore, not legitimate according to the Article 53.1 of the International Code of Nomenclature for Algae, Fungi and Plants (McNeill *et al.* 2012).

We correct the error here by proposing the replacement name *Daustinia* and transferring the only species assigned by us to *Austinia*. The new name proposed maintains the honorific to Daniel F. Austin, for his great contribution to the knowledge in Convolvulaceae.

### ***Daustinia montana* (Moricand) Buril & A.R. Simões comb. nov.**

Basionym: *Ipomoea montana* Moricand (1837: 44, t. 30). *Jacquemontia montana* (Moricand) Meisner in C.F.P. von Martius (1869: 304).

*Thyella montana* (Moricand) House (1906: 314). *Austinia montana* (Moricand) Buril & A.R. Simões (2013: 256), nom. illeg.

TYPE:—BRAZIL. Prov. Bahiensis, Montagnes de la Jacobina, s.d., J.S. Blanchet 2533 (lectotype [designated by Buril & Simões, 2014: 256]) G!, isolectotypes F!, K!, P!).
