Abstract

Species of the subfamily Cypricercinae collected from Thailand, mainly from the Northern Provinces, are here reported and/or (re-) described. Nineteen species, belonging to seven genera were found. Six new species, *Strandesia hornei* sp. nov., *Strandesia sanoamuangae* sp. nov., *Pseudostrandesia gaetani* sp. nov., *Pseudostrandesia ovata* sp. nov., *Pseudostrandesia phetchabunensis* sp. nov. and *Pseudostrandesia thailandensis* sp. nov., are described. A species list of the Cypricercinae in Southeast Asia is given and the general distribution and ecology of the Cypricercinae from Thailand is briefly discussed.
