

Nomenclatural changes in two families of asellote isopods (*Acanthaspidiidae* and *Ischnomesidae*)

Abstract. *Iolanthe* Beddard, 1886a is shown to be a senior synonym of *Acanthaspidia* Stebbing, 1893, the replacement name for the preoccupied *Acanthoniscus* Sars, 1879 (Isopoda: Asellota: Acanthaspidiidae). *Ischnomesus kussakini* nom. nov. is erected as a replacement name for *Ischnomesus antarcticus* (Kussakin, 1982), preoccupied in this combination (Isopoda: Asellota: Ischnomesidae).

Introduction

During an update of the names of asellote isopods on WoRMS (Schotte *et al.* 2008 onwards) and WoRDSS (Glover *et al.* 2015) two unresolved nomenclatural problems were discovered. These involved a question of priority of a genus in Acanthaspidiidae Menzies, 1962a and homonymy of species in Ischnomesidae Hansen, 1916. The issues are resolved here.

Taxonomy

Acanthaspidiidae Menzies, 1962

Type species: *Iolanthe acanthonotus* Beddard, 1886 (by monotypy).

Remarks. Sars (1879) erected the genus *Acanthoniscus* Sars, 1879 for the species *Acanthoniscus typhlops* Sars, 1879, collected from the Norwegian Sea, its type species by monotypy. Beddard (1886a) erected the genus *Iolanthe* Beddard, 1886a for a single new species, *Iolanthe acanthonotus* Beddard, 1886a, collected from south of Kerguelen Island. Beddard (1886b) erected a second genus *Ianthopsis* Beddard, 1886b for *Ianthe bovallii* Studer, 1884. Beddard (1886b) remarked on the close resemblance of this new genus to *Acanthoniscus*. Bovallius (1886) realised that *Acanthoniscus* was preoccupied, a junior homonym of *Acanthoniscus* Kinahan, 1859 (Isopoda: Oniscidea), and although he remarked that it should be replaced with another name, he did not propose one. Stebbing (1893) proposed the replacement name
