On page 26:

We incorrectly stated that the Notostraca were unknown from Chile. However, Soto (1990) reported unidentified notostracans from ephemeral pools at 53° S (Morro Chico).

Page 367

We incorrectly stated that *Branchinecta brushi* Hegna & Lazo-Wasem, 2010 is endemic to Chile. However it has been reported recently from Argentina (Cohen, 2012).

We incorrectly stated that *Branchinecta papillata* Rogers, De los Ríos & Zúñiga, 2008 is endemic to Chile. However it has been reported recently from Argentina (Cohen, 2010, 2012) and from Bolivia (Rogers & Coronel, 2011).

Page 368

Branchinecta valchetana Cohen, 1981 was reported from Paniri Volcano (Rogers et al., 2008), however Hegna & Lazo-Wasem (2010) later described this specific population as *Branchinecta brushi*. In Rogers et al. (2008) it specifically mentioned that the material was given to the authors by Eric Laso-Wasem, and that they had not examined the specimens.

Page 375

Alona cambouei Guerne and Richard, 1893 could fully absent in South America, and all *pulchella*-like populations could belong to *A. glabra* or some other undescribed taxa (Sinev 2001).

Page 376

A neotropical taxon *Coronatella poppei* (Richard, 1897) is very recently redescribed based on material from Brazil (Sousa et al., 2015), and this paper could be important for differentiation of this taxon in Chile.

Page 379

Pleuroxus varidentatus Frey, 1993 was incorrectly listed as "*P. variadentatus*".
