Abstract

A complete bibliography of scientific works of the dipterist, Jacques-Marie-Frangille Bigot, is presented in chronological order with accurate dates of publication. A total of 411 works are listed including taxonomic works, reviews of the works of colleagues, errata, and other types of articles.

Introduction

Jacques-Marie-Frangille Bigot (1818–1893) was extremely prolific in his almost 50 years of work on the taxonomy of Diptera. He published a total of over 2,600 pages in 411 scientific articles and chapters in books in which he described over 1,800 new species and almost 400 new genera of Diptera. His life and work overlapped some of the most noted French dipterists of his time including Macquart and Robineau-Desvoidy. Although he
