

A new species of *Formosiepyris* Terayama, 2004 (Hymenoptera: Bethylidae) from China

Abstract

A new species of the genus *Formosiepyris* Terayama, 2004 is described from Fujian Province, China. A key to the species of *Formosiepyris* is given.

Introduction

The genus *Formosiepyris* Terayama, 2004, belonging to the subfamily Epyrinae (Hymenoptera: Bethylidae), is represented by three species from the Oriental region. *F. marishi* Terayama is known from Thailand, *F. shiva* Terayama from India, and *F. takasago* Terayama from China (Terayama, 2004). In this paper we describe a fourth species belonging to *Formosiepyris*.

Materials and Methods

The descriptions follow the terminology used by Evans (1964) and Terayama (2004). The type specimens have been deposited in the Hymenopteran Collection of Zhejiang University, Hangzhou, China.
