

Two new species of *Indonemoura* (Plecoptera: Nemouridae) from Fujian, China

Abstract

Two new species of the family Nemouridae, *Indonemoura fujianensis* sp. n. and *Indonemoura masuensis* sp. n., are described from Fujian, South China. Their relationships with related species are discussed.

Introduction

The genus *Indonemoura* was erected by Baumann (1975). Since then, 24 species have been recorded from the Oriental region (Aubert 1967; Baumann 1975; Zwick 1977; Zwick & Sivec 1980) and one from the Palaearctic region (Shimizu 1994). We checked type specimens of already known species in the Institute of Zoology, Chinese Academy of Science, and just found that several are in very good condition which do not belong to this genus. Thus, only four species are presently known from China (Zhu, Yang & Yang 2002; Li, Yang & Sivec 2005), *Indonemoura hubeiensis* Yang and Yang, 1991, *I. tibetensis* Zhu, Yang and Yang, 2002, *I. guangxiensis* Li and Yang, 2005 and *I. trispina* Li and Sivec, 2005.

This paper describes two new *Indonemoura* species from Fujian, in southern China. The type material is preserved in 75% alcohol and deposited in the Entomological Museum of China Agricultural University, Beijing. Terminology generally follows that of Baumann (1975).
