Abstract

Herein are recorded and vouchered from Oregon 218 species and subspecies of beetles in the following families: Anobiidae, Anthicidae, Anthribidae, Bostrichidae, Bruchidae, Buprestidae, Cantharidae, Carabidae, Cerambycidae, Cerophytidae, Chrysomelidae, Ciidae, Clambidae, Cleridae, Coccinellidae, Colydiidae, Curculionidae, Dermestidae, Elateridae, Eucnemidae, Glaresidae, Heteroceridae, Histeridae, Latridiidae, Leiodidae, Melandryidae, Meloidae, Melyridae, Nitidulidae, Ochodaeidae, Scarabaeidae, Scolytidae, Staphylinidae, Tenebrionidae, and Tetratomidae. Clarifying information is provided for two more: *Agrilus cuprescens* Ménétrière (Buprestidae) and *Hylis irvinei* Muona (Eucnemidae).

Introduction

The primary purpose of this paper is to add to the knowledge of the coleopteran fauna of Oregon and the Pacific Northwest. While new records of Oregon beetles have been published since M. H. Hatch's monumental work, *Beetles of the Pacific Northwest* (1953, 1957, 1962, 1965, 1971), most have been in scattered revisions and articles. This paper includes records of species not known to have been formally documented from Oregon, based on information acquired as the result of an ongoing effort to list the entire beetle fauna of the state by two of us (GLP and JRL) and J. C. Miller.
