



## Synopsis of the genus *Colobothea* Lepeletier & Audinet-Serville in Bolivia, with descriptions of two new species and new country records (Coleoptera, Cerambycidae)

### Abstract

A synopsis of the Bolivian species of *Colobothea* Lepeletier & Audinet-Serville is presented. Two new species are described: *C. berkovi* Monné & Monné, **sp. nov.** and *C. wappesi* Monné & Monné, **sp. nov.** New distributional data are given for *C. naevigera* Bates, 1865, *C. hirtipes* (Degeer, 1775), *C. appendiculata* Aurivillius, 1902, *C. assimilis* Aurivillius, 1902, *C. plagiata* Aurivillius, 1902, and *C. pictilis* Bates, 1865. All the species are illustrated. A key to the Bolivian species is provided.

### Resumo

Uma sinopse das espécies bolivianas do gênero *Colobothea* Lepeletier & Audinet-Serville é apresentada. Duas novas espécies são descritas: *C. berkovi* Monné & Monné, **sp. n.** e *C. wappesi* Monné & Monné, **sp. n.** Novos dados de distribuição são fornecidos para *C. naevigera* Bates, 1865, *C. hirtipes* (Degeer, 1775), *C. appendiculata* Aurivillius, 1902, *C. assimilis* Aurivillius, 1902, *C. plagiata* Aurivillius, 1902 e *C. pictilis* Bates, 1865. Todas as espécies são ilustradas. Uma chave para as espécies bolivianas é adicionada.

### Introduction

The composition of the Neotropical tribe Colobotheini was recently summarized by Monné & Monné (2009). The genus *Colobothea* Lepeletier & Audinet-Serville, 1825, with 117 species, is the largest of the tribe. One way to organize studies of this group is according to arbitrary limits defined by the political borders of countries, in this case, Bolivia.
