### Abstract

Several species of the infaunal alpheid genera *Leptalpheus* Williams, 1965 and *Fenneralpheus* Felder & Manning, 1986 are described as new or reported from new localities in the tropical western Atlantic and eastern Pacific. In the genus *Leptalpheus*, five species are described as new: *L. marginalis* sp. nov. from the Caribbean coast of Colombia; *L. penicillatus* sp. nov. from the Pacific coast of Panama and Costa Rica; *L. azuero* sp. nov., *L. hendrickxi* sp. nov., and *L. bicristatus* sp. nov., all three from the Pacific coast of Panama. In addition, *L. cf. forceps* Williams, 1965 and *L. felderri* Anker, Vera Caripe & Lira, 2006 are reported for the first time from the Caribbean coast of Panama. Several unidentified species of *Leptalpheus* presently known from incomplete or immature specimens are also reported. In the genus *Fenneralpheus*, *F. orabovis* sp. nov. is described as new, whereas *F. chacei* Felder & Manning, 1986 is reported from the Caribbean coast of Panama, representing the first finding of this species outside its type locality in Florida. The generic diagnoses of both *Leptalpheus* and *Fenneralpheus* are emended to accommodate the new species.
