Contribution to the knowledge of the subtribe Mastigerina (Coleoptera: Staphylinidae: Pselaphinae, Clavigeritae), with a description of a new genus from Borneo.

Page 52: The correct key to genera of the subtribe Mastigerina is the following one:

- 1 Apex of terminal antennomere rounded, with long dense setae3
- Apex of terminal antennomere truncate, with short setae or setae absent2

- 2 Base of elytra with well-defined, oblique trichomes, vertexal foveae absent, antennae 4-segmented.....
..... *Tasmiger* Besuchet
- Base of elytra lacking trichomes, vertexal foveae well-defined, antennae 3-segmented
..... *Mastiger* Motschulsky

- 3 Temples very long, head octagonal, humeri prominent *Longacerus* g. nov.
- Temples short, usually covered by facets connecting dorsal and ventral parts of eyes, humeri carinate, not prominent *Pseudacerus* Raffray
