

First record of the genera *Luzarida* Hebard, 1928 and *Luzaridella* Desutter-Grandcolas, 1992 (Orthoptera, Gryllidae, Phalangopsinae) from Brazil, including a new species and description of the female of *Luzarida lata* Gorochov, 2011

Abstract

Luzarida and *Luzaridella* are first recorded from Brazil. A new species of *Luzaridella* and the female of *Luzarida lata* is described from Central Amazon. Habitus, morphological characteristics, male and female genitalia photographs are provided. Calling song of *Luzarida lata* and *Luzaridella* sp. nov. are characterized.

Introduction

Luzarini Herbard, 1928 includes 61 genera and 289 valid species, occurring in Central and South America, as well as Caribbean Islands and Sub-Saharan Africa (Eades *et al.* 2012). Many authors (Vickery 1976; Desutter-Grandcolas 1992, 1993, 1994; Mello & Pellegatti-Franco 1998; Mews *et al.* 2009; 2010; Bolfarini & Mello 2012; Eades *et al.* 2012) have dismissed this tribe in favor of subfamily Luzarinae.

Subtribe Luzarina was erected by Gorochov (2011) to group genera *Luzara* Walker, 1869, *Luzarida* Hebard, 1928, *Niquirana* Hebard, 1928, *Luzaridella* Desutter-Grandcolas, 1992, *Acantoluzarida* Desutter-Grandcolas, 1992, *Aracamby* Mello, 1992, *Leptopsis* Desutter-Grandcolas, 1996, *Ucayacla* Gorochov, 2011, *Peruzara* Gorochov, 2011, and *Amazonacla* Gorochov, 2011.

Luzarida presents seven valid species (Eades *et al.* 2012) two from French Guiana: *L. guyana* Desutter-Grandcolas, 1992 and *L. grandis* Desutter-Grandcolas, 1992; two from Colombia: *L. annuliger* Hebard, 1928 and *L. pulla* Hebard, 1928; one from Ecuador: *L. recondita* (Nischk & Otte 2000); one from Trinidad & Tobago: *L. gracilior* Hebard, 1928, and one from Guyana: *L. lata* Gorochov, 2011.

Luzaridella includes three valid species, all from French Guiana (Eades *et al.* 2012): *L. annulata* Desutter-Grandcolas, 1992, *L. clara* Desutter-Grandcolas, 1992 and *L. obscura* Desutter-Grandcolas, 1992.

The aim of this work was to register the genera *Luzarida* and *Luzaridella* for the first time from Brazil, and to describe a new species of *Luzaridella* highlighting male genitalia, tegmina morphology and calling song. We also describe the female and present male calling song of *Luzarida lata*.

Materials and Methods

The crickets were collected from the Reserva Florestal Adolpho Ducke, municipality of Manaus, state of Amazonas, Brazil (02°55'S, 59°58'W).
